Non-cognizable complaint registered against Javed Akhtar for 'defaming RSS'

ANON-COGNIZABLE complaint was registered at Mulund police station on Sunday against poet and lyricist Javed Akhtar, alleging that he defamed the RSS with his remarks during his interview to a news channel.

The complainant, Santosh Dubey, 44, a lawyer, told the police that he is an RSS supporter. The complainant against Akhtar was lodged under Section 500 of IPC for defamation.

"I saw a video on YouTube in September where, while speaking with NDTV, Javed Akhtar compared the RSS with Taliban. I have given the transcription of his comments to police as well as the video. The police have taken my NC and so I have decided to approach the honourable magistrate court next week where I will request the magistrate to order Mulund police to lodge an FIR against him," said Dubey.

Price of CNG, PNG hiked from today

## Advocate critical after her car hit by speeding BMW

A 30-YEAR-OLD advocate is battling for her life in the ICU of a hospital with grievous head injuries after her car was rammed by a speeding BMW on the Bandra-Worli sea link in the early hours of Sunday.

The incident took place around 1.30 am on the north-bound stretch of the sea link when Saloni Samir Lakhya, a resident of Khar (west), was driving back home in her Celerio car.

The accused, Sachin Kharatmal, 45, a resident of Malad west, was said to be in an

inebriated condition at the time of the accident. He was arrested after the incident but granted bail later in the day.

Kharatmal was returning home with his sister and brother-in-law when he rammed his car into Lakhya's vehicle, which got mangled from the rear due to the impact, police said, adding Lakhya suffered grievous internal injury on her head.

Police rushed her to Bhabha

Hospital and later, her relatives admitted her to a private hospital where her condition is said to be serious. Kharatmal's sister, too, suffered a fracture in her hand.

In absence of a complainant, on-duty assistant sub inspector Dilip Sawant registered a suo motu FIR against Kharatmal for rash driving, causing grievous injury, dangerous driving and drink driving under sections 279 and 338 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), and 184 and 185 of the Motor Vehicle (MV) Act.

Kharatmal was granted bail on Sunday. The police said the accident was not a case of hit-and-run, adding the accused was arrested from the spot and his car seized.

## Pilot demands judicial probe into 3,000kg heroin seizure in Gujarat

SENIOR CONGRESS leader Sachin Pilot demanded a judicial probe into the DRI seizure of 3,000 kg of heroin worth Rs 20,000 crore from the Mundra Port in Gujarat. Pilot was on a one-day visit to Mumbai and addressed the media at the city Congress headquarters. Addressing the seizure of drugs in Gujarat, he said that there was a danger to national security. "What was the need for a Vishakhapatnam-based company to order consignment in Gujarat?" he said.

Pilot alleged that this was the tip of an iceberg and earlier drugs worth thousands of crores were brought into the country.

He demanded that an independent, unbiased probe should be conducted as it is an issue that will affect future generations and national security.

The Congress leader said that "The government wants to suppress the case save their own government. There is no firm action taken even after a huge cache was caught. A local court had directed DRI for strict action and no action seems to have been taken."

Pilot also condemned the action by the Yogi Adityanath-led Uttar Pradesh government against AICC general secretary Priyanka Gandhi and demanded a judicial probe into the Lakhimpur Khairi incident in which agitating farmers were killed on Sunday.

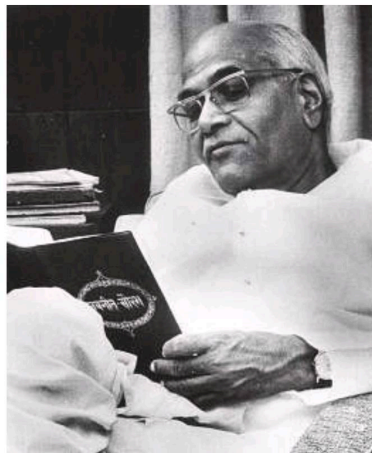
